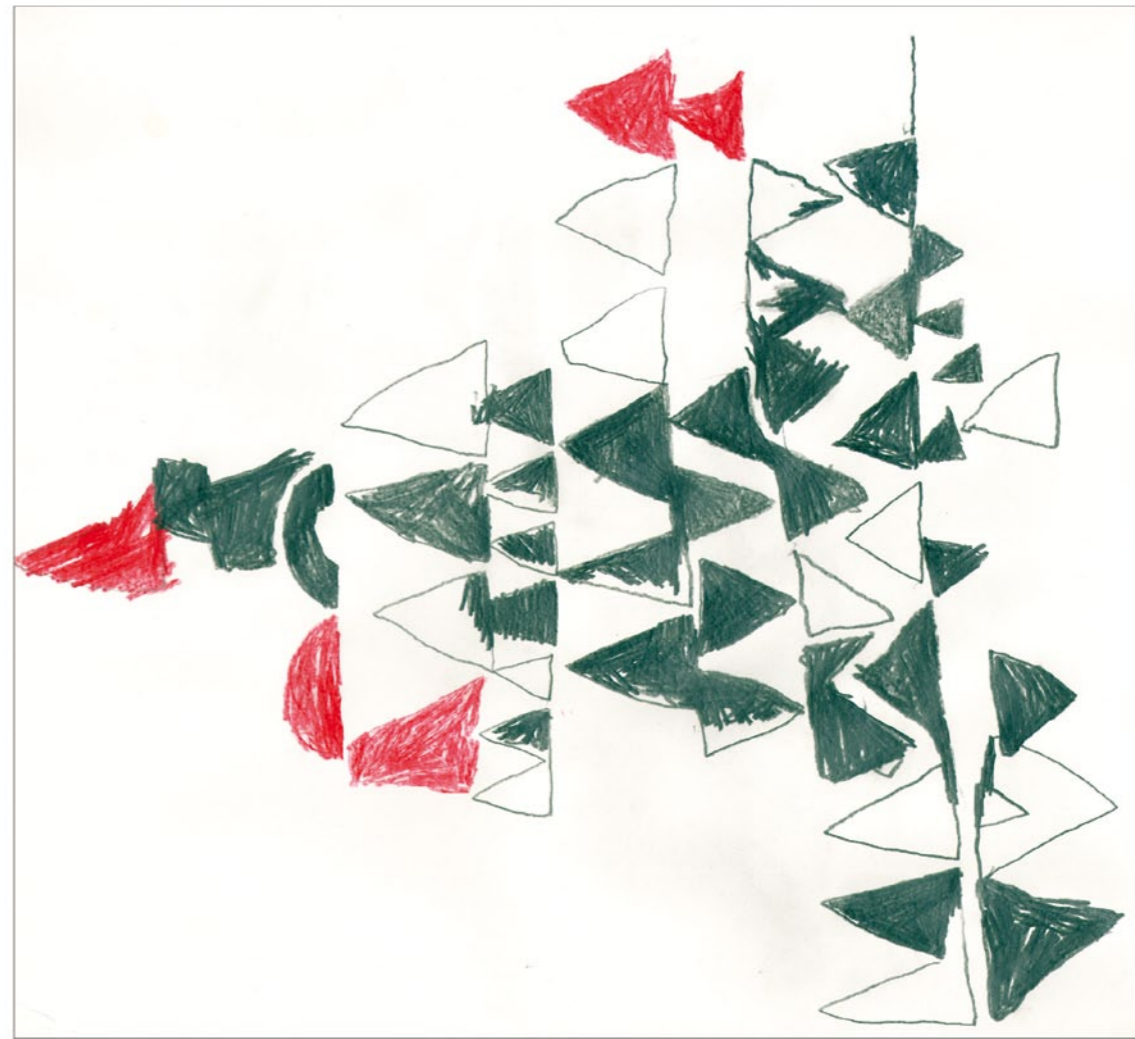

HOW IT WORKS

The concept behind coca braun

The Editors

Have responsibility for all aspects of the production of the magazine.

The Photographers/Artists

Submit their work to be published in the magazine or get in contact to ask the editors to add their link on cocabraun.com.

The Funder

Receives a 20 euro contribution fee and makes considered decisions about how public expenditure should be allocated.

Advertisement

Every two month we start a poster campaign each time showing an artwork of one of the participants.

Finding Work for Publication

Editors travel to galleries and bookstores across the Netherlands and Germany giving artists the opportunity to present their work for publication.

Editorial Discussion

Editors and artists meet informally and discuss future subjects for the magazine.

Distribution

Different distribution companies ship the magazine to outlets in Germany and in the Netherlands.

The Reader

Enjoys the resulting magazine.
